















STEP 5: Hang the second door panel. Adjust the trolleys to the desired height to obtain a level and smooth appearence.








STEP 7: Handle installation must be done before adjustable door stops on stay blocks are installed.





STEP 8: Using the pre-drilled holes in the door panel, attach the C-Channel to one door using self-tapping screws provided (yellow bag). Pair 2 of the rubber bumpers using the self-tapping screws at the top and bottom of the C-Channel as shown. This provides a quiet close.












Step 14

*For doors without glass.

Close and center doors. Place jamb latch plate at desired height. Mark the opening of the jamb latch plate on to the core of the slider. Drill this area out no more than the thickness of the plywood.

The top of the Jamb latch should be flush with the latch location. (Refer to Step 12).
